

“Your Neighbours”

Where to go for the freshest fish, the coolest beer and the warmest welcome. Here's a tour of Gulluk from Mike, our man on the ground.

Walking from the North end of Gulluk the first place is **Omar's Bar** which is a small but nice beach bar & cafe.

Next is the **Palm Beach Restaurant** which has a wooden sundeck on the beach opposite. This is meant to be a very good restaurant and comes highly recommended by Kirk in **Joes Bar**. Then round to **Tikisik** which is a popular bar for the younger crowd of an evening. This is quite lively and good for music and drinks.



Next to this is the **Yelken Cafe** with an excellent raised terrace and good cheap food.



Walking into the next bay which is the town beach, there is **Hermias Hotel** and Restaurant. This hotel offers a very nice rooftop restaurant overlooking the beach. Just 100m further along is **Mimosa Café Bar**. This is a simple place with good cheap local food.

On the corner of the main bay and the port, near the **dolphin boy statue**, there is a large restaurant cafe bar called **Angels Port**. They have a good selection of fish & meats and free WIFI!

There's quite a lot happening as you walk around the bay, **Kucuk Restaurant** is good for fish & pizza pide. Next to that is a fresh fish shop, the **Ayca Internet cafe** and then the **Kordon Motel & Restaurant**. This then brings you to the centre of

the port and two traditional old warehouse buildings with tables & chairs outside. The first is the **Cicek Restaurant** and next to it is **Eskii Depo**. They all are highly recommended and offer good cheap food.

Local street sellers also do great stuffed mussels, delicious.

Above Eski's is the **Hann Bar** which is always busy when they have live Turkish folk music. Below this is a club called **Deep House** which is fairly quiet. Then it's onto **Joes Bar**, which is very popular with foreigners and is an informal tourist information point. If you need to know anything just ask Kirk!

Next to Joes is a bank with a cash point. Opposite is the **Old Tea House** which is run by the Beldiyre which is why it's so cheap and great for local food. In the main square is the mayor's office and also the **medical centre**. Just off the square is the local market which is every Thursday. The taxi rank is located at the end of the main pier.



There are 3 supermarkets in Gulluk as well as loads of smaller shops.

Migros is the largest in centre of town and **Bim** is 100m from **Flipflops Apartments**. Moving on past the pier on the left is **Cetin Restaurant** great for cheap pide and next on the right is **Dildado Café** again very simple but good. By the fishing boats there are few stalls selling fresh fish and the **Kirchin Restaurant** is next door which has a growing reputation.

Then onto **Fuegos** which is the height of sophistication. A great beach club during the day and an excellent restaurant club atmosphere in the evenings. We highly recommend here!

Finally there is the **Ozkan Beach Bar & Cafe** which is a great location for lazing

around and chilling.

This should be enough to get you started and of course you are welcome to just stay at **Flipflops Apartments** and not move from the poolside!
